

2013 Men's Club Rules

Except for best shot events, USGA rules regarding moving the ball in play (“summer rules”) apply. This includes all “weekly event” play.

USGA rules shall otherwise govern play, except as modified by local rules.

Monthly Events

Men’s Club events are held one Sunday morning a month from May-October. Team events are conducted, usually with shotgun starts, with the exception of the Club Championship which is based on individual scores. All pairings are made by the Golf Shop staff, with every attempt made to provide fun and fair competition for all players.

Weekly Events

1. All weekly events are 9 hole events played on the front 9. Players wishing to play 18 holes may continue as usual to the back 9.
2. **Weekly events will be conducted on Wednesdays & Saturdays.** Players may play at any time of the day and may make tee times in accordance with regular tee time policies.
3. **NEW THIS YEAR - “New Member & Others” tee times will be made available to assist New Members in finding a game.** Whenever possible, at least one New Member & Others tee time will be available in the early afternoon (Between 12:00 – 1:00) and late afternoon (after 3:00) Wednesday, and Saturday if available.
4. There is a \$2 fee for playing in a weekly event, which must be paid in the Golf Shop before play.
5. All players are required to post their ESC score immediately after play. 9 or 18 hole scores must be posted. Soldiers Field Men’s Club handicaps are frequently monitored by other golfers. Many members take pride in their accuracy and honesty.

Events are announced weekly and include both individual and 2-man partner formats. If you do not have a partner, another player’s scores will be combined with yours in a “blind draw”. Events will include individual low net, horserace points, 2 man best ball, 2 man points, and other events. A player must sign up in advance of play in the Golf Shop, have the round witnessed by an adult playing companion (adults 18 and older), and turn the completed scorecard into the Golf Shop immediately after play. Weekly scores should be posted by the player and should **not** be recorded as tournament scores.
